

## Interesting Facts About Idaho



Idaho borders six U.S. states and Canada. The six states are Washington, Oregon, Montana, Nevada, Utah, and Wyoming.

Idaho's key industries are manufacturing, agriculture, and tourism.

Idaho is one of the biggest producers of food, lumber, machinery, paper products, chemical products, electronics, silver, and other natural materials (mining), and tourism in the nation.

The world's largest factory for barrel cheese is in Gooding, Idaho.

The first alpine chairlift was in Sun Valley, Idaho. In 1936, a lift ticket cost 63 cents.

The deepest river gorge in North America is Hells Canyon in Idaho and is 7,900 feet deep!

Borah Peak is the highest point in Idaho at 12,662 feet.

Idaho has North America's tallest single sand dune —470 feet— in at Bruneau Dunes.

Shoshone Falls in Idaho is known as the “Niagra of the West.” The falls are 900 feet wide and 212 feet tall. Niagra Falls is 167 feet tall.

Idaho sells 70% of the US's supply of trout.

Idaho has more whitewater river miles than any other U.S. state. There are 10,000 miles of river in Idaho, 3,100 of them being whitewater miles.

The gondola at Silver Mountain Resort in Kellogg is the longest gondola ride in North America.

The longest floating boardwalk in the world is in Coeur d'Alene.

One percent of Yellowstone National Park is in Idaho.

Idaho is known for its heavy wine consumption. A study done in 2021 states that Idaho drinks more wine per capita than any other state.

Famous people who have homes in Coeur d'Alene include John Elway, Wayne Gretsky, Matthew McConaughey, Lance Armstrong, and George Clooney.

Idaho's state seal is the only seal to have been designed by a woman, Emma Green.
